RN1	Best Exterior Renovation	Entrants may submit an exterior renovation exclusively or an exterior renovation that was done as part of a larger renovation project.



RN2	Best Kitchen Renovation	Entrants may submit for kitchen renovations or a kitchen that was renovated as part of a larger renovation project.
RN3	Best Renovation under \$300,000	Entrants may submit any renovation that meets the guidelines outlined in the Renovation Awards Criteria Pack and falls under \$300,000.
RN4	Best Renovation \$300,001 to \$600,000	Entrants may submit any renovation that meets the guidelines outlined in the Renovation Awards Criteria Pack and falls between \$300,001 and \$600,000.
RN5	Best Renovation over \$600,000	Entrants may submit any renovation that meets the guidelines outlined in the Renovation Awards Criteria Pack and falls over \$600,001.

Code	Award Category	Description
GM1	Best Supplying / Manufacturing Member	Members that supply and/or manufacture for builders/developers who are BILD Edmonton Metro Members.
GM2	Best Installation Member	Members that install for builders/developers who are BILD Edmonton Metro Members.
GM3	Best Construction Service Provider	Members that provide an intangible construction service for builders/developers who are BILD Edmonton Metro Members. Such as utilities, construction companies, some contractors, etc.
GM4	Best Professional Service Provider	Members that provide an intangible professional service for builders/developers who are BILD Edmonton Metro Members. Such as marketing agencies, architects, consultants, etc.

DV1	Best New Community	Must have sold the first lot or home between October 1, 2023, and September 30, 2026.
DV2	Best HOA Community	To qualify the community must have a legally incorporated HOA and have been undergoing an active development phase between October 1, 2025, and September 30, 2026.
DV3	Best Non-HOA Community	To qualify the community must not have an HOA and have been undergoing an active development phase between October 1, 2025, and September 30, 2026.
DV4	Best Mixed-Use Development	A development constructed to provide both residential and commercial space on one site.
DV5	Best Low-Rise Rental Project	Residential developments between zero to three stories.
DV6	Best Mid-Rise Rental Project	Residential developments between four and eight stories.
DV7	Best High-Rise Rental Project	Residential developments over nine stories.

Code	Award Category	Description
MF1	Best Apartment Style	An individual unit that opens off a common corridor.
MF2	Best Greenfield Townhouse / Semi / Rowhouse / Duplex	Multi-unit homes must be built on an area of land that has not previously been developed.
MF3	Best Infill Townhouse / Semi / Rowhouse / Duplex	Multi-unit infill homes must be built in place of an existing structure in the Edmonton Region to qualify.
MF4	Best Multi-Family under \$350,000	Entrants may submit any multi-unit home that meets the guidelines outlined in the Multi-Family Awards Criteria Pack and falls under \$350,000.
MF5	Best Multi-Family T/D \$350,001 to \$400,000	Entrants may submit any multi-unit home that meets the guidelines outlined in the Multi-Family Awards Criteria Pack and falls between \$350,001 to \$400,000.
MF6	Best Multi-Family T/D \$400,001 to \$450,000	Entrants may submit any multi-unit home that meets the guidelines outlined in the Multi-Family Awards Criteria Pack and falls between \$400,001 to \$450,000.
MF7	Best Multi-Family T/D over \$450,001	Entrants may submit any multi-unit home that meets the guidelines outlined in the Multi-Family Awards Criteria Pack and falls over \$450,001.
SS1	Best Garden / Secondary Suite	Best Greenfield or Infill Garden / Garage / Secondary Suite. The suite must be a separate dwelling within or an accessory building from a single detached, semi-detached, or row house, with its own living, cooking, sleeping, and bathroom facilities. Must be legally permitted for use as an additional dwelling by a regional municipality.

SF3	Best Single Family \$400,001 to \$450,000	Entrants may submit any home that meets the guidelines outlined in the Single-Family Awards Criteria Pack and falls between \$400,001 to \$450,000.
SF4	Best Single Family \$450,001 to \$500,000	Entrants may submit any home that meets the guidelines outlined in the Single-Family Awards Criteria Pack and falls between \$450,001 to \$500,000.
