The Industry Leader Awards honour nine (9) member companies for their excellent contributions to priorities and values that propel the industry and association forward.

- Environmental Excellence (General Member)
- Environmental Excellence
- Design Innovation
- Safety Excellence
- Renovator of the Year
- General Member of the Year
- Developer of the Year
- Builder of the Year – Small Volume
- Builder of the Year – Large Volume
- Builder of the Year – Multi-Family

Guidelines

- This category will be judged by a special panel of experts in the respective fields.

Safety Excellence:

- All companies managed by one main safety contact must enter collectively under one company name. The submission must include a WCB Employer Premium Rate Statement (PDF) for all companies that are part of your entry. The WCB and COR information from each company must be included. The totals from each company will be averaged by BILD Edmonton Metro and used in the entry.

Builder of the Year:

- Large volume builders are the ones that complete more than 75 units in the specified time frame.
- Small volume builders are the ones that complete less than 75 units in the specified time frame.

Builder of the Year Awards

- The Environmental Excellence, Leadership Contribution, and Safety Excellence Awards contribute to the tabulation of the Developer of the Year, General Member



of the Year, Renovator of the Year, and Builder of the Year Awards. Please refer to the Tabulation Chart in the AOE Submission Guide for point allocation.

Number of Submissions

- Maximum one submission per award.

Submission Package

Follow the general instructions described in the AOE Submission Guide, as well as submit:

- Online entry form
- Any Supplementary Forms as outlined in the AOE Submission Guide.
- A maximum of five (5) supplementary material (e.g., staff surveys, training material, strategic plans, workplace posters) that clearly apply to that the applicant is submitting to.

Evaluation

Each submission to an award in this category should detail how their submission has met the following criteria.

Criteria	Weight (%)
Description (Summary of company, their initiatives, and how it applies to award)	40%
Creativity, Innovations, and Special Qualities	25%
Evaluation, Success Metrics, and Contribution to Industry	10%

Judges will also be evaluating graphic attachments submitted with the following weights:
