



Renovation Awards

Overview

The Renovation Awards honour five (5) member companies for their excellence in planning, design, and construction related to renovations throughout the Edmonton Metropolitan Region.

- Best Exterior Renovation
- Best Kitchen Renovation
- Best Renovation under \$300,000
- Best Renovation between \$300,001 and \$600,000
- Best Renovation over \$600,001

Guidelines

- Members who are not part of the RenoMark program and who have not obtained all necessary permits will not be evaluated.
- Any home in litigation at the time of submission is not eligible for entry.
- Submissions that are not considered complete (fully livable) will not be considered.
- If a renovation was entered in a previous year, it is not eligible to enter this year's competition.
- A Signed Homeowners Waiver Form is required for the Home Renovation Awards as well as for any customer home. The project name on the Homeowners Waiver Form must match the project name on the online submission. If there is any discrepancy, the project name on the Homeowner Waiver Form will be used. This form should only be submitted with your entry as an uploaded PDF.
- Price specification for renovation categories – Include: the total cost of the renovation (excluding land and GST). Submissions may only be entered in the category corresponding to the total cost of the renovation and cannot be submitted in part to the lesser renovation category.
- Renovation submitted must be completed by the specific company submitting the application (cannot be combined with company that has the same name as in a franchise).
- Lottery homes, staff purchases, and builder owner homes must be submitting the selling price as if the home/unit were sold to the public. Must have third-party appraisal in support of their submissions.



Renovator of the Year Award

- Awards in this category qualify for the Renovator of the Year Award. Please refer to the Tabulation Chart in the AOE Submission Guide for point allocation.

Number of Submissions

- Maximum three submissions per award.

Submission Package

Follow the general instructions described in the AOE Submission Guide, as well as submit:

- Online entry form
- Any Supplementary Forms as outlined in the AOE Submission Guide.
- A maximum of ten (10) images, floorplans, or construction drawings may be submitted for review.

Evaluation

Each submission to an award in this category should detail how their submission has met the following criteria.

Criteria	Weight (%)
Description (e.g., type of renovation, solutions, challenges and opportunities)	40%
Creativity, Innovations, and Special Qualities	20%
Evaluation and Success Metrics	10%

Judges will also be evaluating graphic attachments submitted with the following weights:
